FEES

- Option 1: With homestay accommodation \$2,500 USD
- Option 2: Without accommodation \$1,500 USD

INCLUDES:

- Welcome and orientation session.
- Spanish language classes.
- Mexican and Mayan culture courses taught by UNAM professors and researchers.
- Three Spanish practical sessions (transportation included).
- Three field trips to Chichén Itzá, Uxmal, and cenotes, including transportation, meals, and the possibility of taking the Mayan Train.
- · Certificate of completion with an official transcript.

REFUND POLICY

- If CEPHCIS-UNAM cancels the course, a 100% refund will be issued.
- No refunds will be given after the registration deadline.

- 2. Take the Spanish placement test.
- 3. Make a USD 100 deposit and email proof of payment along with proof of major medical insurance to idiomas@cephcis.unam.mx by the specified deadline.
- 4. Pay the remaining balance upon arrival in Mérida.

Registration deadline: Participants must submit proof of payment and a copy of their medical insurance coverage for Mexico by the designated date.
