Have major medical insurance valid in Mexico.

Take a Spanish placement test (administered remotely by CEPHCIS-UNAM).

Not needed for beginner level.

Complete the registration process and make the corresponding payment.

Spanish language classes.

Mexican and Mayan culture courses taught by UNAM professors and researchers.

Three Spanish practical sessions (transportation included).

Three field trips to Chichén Itzá, Uxmal, and the beach, including transportation, meals, and the possibility of taking the Mayan Train.

Certificate of completion with an official transcript.

REFUND POLICY

If CEPHCIS-UNAM cancels the course, a 100% refund will be issued.

No refunds will be given after the registration deadline.

- 3. After the confirmation, you will get information for the payment and the placement test. Make sure to complete this step before the deadline.
- 4. Send the proof of major medical insurance to idiomas@cephcis.unam.mx by the specified deadline.

Registration deadline: Participants must submit proof of payment and a copy of their medical insurance coverage for Mexico by the designated date.
